Device Front & Back

Bypass / On / Off: Standard 3-way switch for all FX devices in Reason. You can **Bypass** the audio routing of the device, turn the device **On** to enable the device, or turn it **Off** entirely.

Patch Browser: Look! It can save your favorite patches too. Which means that it comes with loads of patches created by the hard work of others. So you're not only getting a device that's craptastic, you're getting other shitty patches by other crappy developers too! Up down arrows take you to the previous / next patches in the folder. The Folder icon opens the Reason browser. The disk icon saves your own poopy patches. And if you don't know how this part of the devices work by now, you need to get my book already.

Volume: The proprietary crappy Volume Rotary adds more grit and distortion for those times when you need to hear what a unicorn sounds like when he / she shits rainbows. Push it up when dialed into Super Crap and watch Reason actually EXPLODE into a big pile of dung.

Unicorn: This is the real reason you need this device. I mean, what other time are you going to see a Unicorn crapping candy in a Combinator Skin? Eat your heart out My Little Pony! Ride on into the big blue sky happy Unicorn buddy. May all your audio dreams come true.



The Kittens: They say that every time the Crapre is Bypassed, a Kitten dies. So don't bypass! Instead, Drive up the Input Rotary and recall your yesteryear when Walkmans were chic and an HB pencil was actually useful to rewind your tapes. Ahhh those were the days.

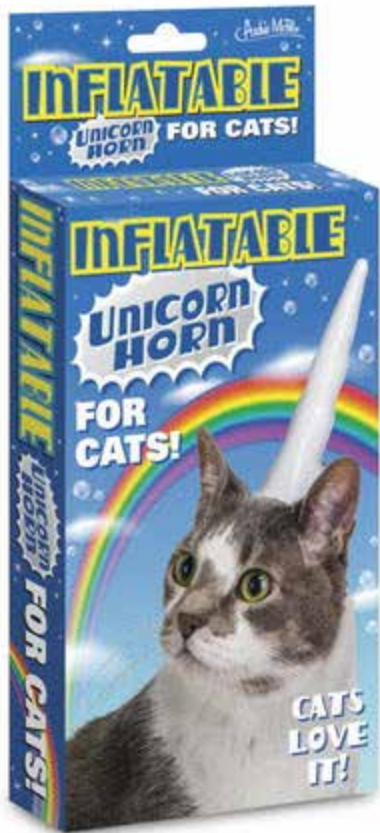
Input: Crap Gain. It goes from 0-100. Do you really need more of an explanation? Yeah, there's a spelling mistake on the mouseover. I just call it the "IT" knob.

SPRING: Springy spongy soft crap Reverb. It's steaming. Click it On or Off. And jump back into Reverbalicious heaven.

Tape Quality Switch: 3 positions: **Bad**, **Bader Tape**, and **Super CRAP!** Ahhh the good sounds of distorted messed up tape. I can almost hear my ears bleeding. It's bliss. Pure bliss.
